Obituary

World Archery was informed of the sudden passing of Charles Kapichi, vice president of the Malawi Archery Association, following a stroke on 28 October 2019. He was the person in charge of the national federation since the president became deputy commander of the government's defense force. The ceremony took place on 30 October.

Awards

Best male athlete

Italy's Mauro Nespoli has been named the best male athlete of the Minsk 2019 European Games by the Association of National Olympic Committees at its annual award ceremony on 17 October in Doha, Qatar. Ten athletes across the five continental games were presented awards. Mauro was recurve men's champion at the continental multisport event, and also collected mixed team gold and men's team bronze.

Achievements

World record

Kim Woojin has scored 352 out of a possible 360 points for 36 arrows at 50 metres to set a new world record at the 100th National Sports Festival in Seoul, Korea. The previous mark of 351 points was shot by another Korean archer, Kim Hyung Ho, back in September 1997. It was the oldest standing outdoor record.

World records

Chinese archers set three new world records at the 2019 Asian Para Championships in Bangkok, Thailand. Wu Chunyan and Wang Sijun raised the recurve mixed team record by six points to 1287. Lin Yueshan and He Zihao scored 1395 to increase the compound mixed team record by 14 points. Lin, Zhou and Li Xinru also added 30 points to the compound women's open team qualifying world best to raise it at 2067.

Events

Road to Tokyo

Maja Jager has become the first archer to be officially named to a team headed to the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games following a joint announcement from Archery Denmark and the Danish Olympic Committee. Denmark did not qualify any places for the Olympic archery competitions in 2016. A total of 128 archers -64 men and 64 women - will compete for five medals at the next Olympics. Over the next 290 days, Denmark will try to add to its single quota spot.

Hong Kong China, Mongolia and Sri Lanka qualified their first athletes to the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games as China, Iran, Korea, Malaysia and Thailand added to their quotas at the continental qualification tournament held as part of the 2019 Asian Para Archery Championships in Bangkok, Thailand. A total of 26 nations now own at least one of the 89 secured spaces for the next Paralympics. Upcoming continental qualification events in Europe and the Americas will award the next 20 spots.

Coaching

Level 1 OS course

From 16 to 21 September 2019, 13 coaches from five of the 10 provinces of Zimbabwe took part in a level 1 coach course in Harare organised by World Archery in collaboration with Olympic Solidarity and the national archery federation. The training was conducted in English by Marja Woortman, assisted by local expert Stephen Mudawarima, and included a written and oral evaluation.



Level 2 OS course

From 2 to 8 September 2019, 18 coaches from World Archery Americas took part in a regional level 2 coaching course in Guayaquil, Ecuador, organised by World Archery in collaboration with Olympic Solidarity and the Mexican archery federation. The training was conducted in Spanish by local expert Santiago Avitia Martinez.



Para archery seminar

The second African para archery seminar took place in the facilities of the national centre for preparation of sports talent and elite in October 2019 in Souidania, Algeria. Thirty-one coaches obtained their World Archery level 1 coaching qualification and 19 coaches developed skills that will allow them to introduce archery to people with disabilities.
